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■ Q & A :

How do the spiritual forces that oppose us view pray?

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■ Q & A :

How does God expect me to persist in prayer when I don't sense His power or see Him working?

When I pray in the Spirit, sometimes I still don't see answers. Is there anything that makes my prayer deficient?

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■ Q & A :

Is there greater power in prayers when more people are praying for the same thing? (e.g. individual vs. corporate prayer)
